13 years for transparent and opaque systems

GUARANTEE PROMISE

When the products are treated in a suitable manner according to instructions in our technical data sheets as well as in compliance with our working guidelines, we guarantee that:

- no maintenance coating is necessary during the guarantee period
- no greying occurs
- the coating will not peel

GUARANTEE COVERAGE

If, during the guarantee time, the wood greys, the structure of the coating changes, the coating peels off, or the coating doesn't fulfil the function expected, ADLER will cover the costs for rehabilitating the relevant component by applying a suitable (rehabilitation) coating through painting or spraying. The selection of the method as well as the material to be used and the type of rehabilitation is exclusively the responsibility of ADLER. Any exceeding requirements and claims are excluded. Guarantee coverage from ADLER does not extend the quarantee period.

STATUTORY GUARANTEE

Statutory guarantee claims are constituted irrespective of the guarantee promise. Guarantee coverage has no impact on the duration of the guarantee.

GUARANTEE CONDITIONS

ADLER products must be handled according to the technical data sheets and working guidelines. Similarly, applicable standards and guidelines must be observed for the construction and storage of windows. Compliance with the construction monitoring obligation as well as the proper assembly of wooden windows and doors according to the state of the art and measures intended for protection during the construction phase according to the VFF data sheet VOB.03 must be ensured. The general terms and conditions of the ADLER-Werk Lackfabrik Johann Berghofer GmbH & Co KG must also be observed.

All detailed guarantee conditions in relation to the species of wood and the coating system are available in the working guideline 310 "Working guideline for the coating of dimensionally stable components - Diamond systems", construction and processing guidelines as well as general information such as wood quality are included in the working guideline 300 "Working guideline for the coating of dimensionally stable components - General part".

GUARANTEE EXCLUSIONS

EXCLUDED FROM THE GUARANTEE ARE THE FOLLOWING:

- Damage caused by force majeure, mechanical action (e.g. improper use, hailstorms and the like) or that is due to the fact that such damage was not promptly remedied in a proper and professional manner.
- Damage that is not reported to ADLER within 14 days of the occurrence of the damage.
- Damage that occurred due to improper maintenance and care by the customer.
- Damage due to high construction moisture or unexpected, unusual moisture exposure, impact of humidity, and similar.
- Damage caused by subsequent works.
- Cracks and compressions due to statics as well as construction defects.
- Colour changes through darkening or fading of the wood.
- Surface defects due to the flow of resin.
- Damage that has occurred due to water ingress and unsealed sealant joints
- Changes to gloss degree and colour during the guarantee period (these must be accepted according to the state of the art).

- Cracks that can be traced back to the substrate.
- Changes in the coating that can be considered as normal ageing.
- Damage to windows placed at an altitude of more than 1600 m and those in the immediate proximity of the sea at a distance of less than 50 m from the beach (continuous exposure to sand).
- Planning defects.

TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CUSTOMER

The end customer must clean the surface at least once a year and check for any mechanical damage (for example due to hail and storm) and whether the sealant joints are intact. Any identified damage must be removed immediately.

Corrections to sealants may only be undertaken by the window manufacturer or painters. Annual cleaning with ADLER Top-Cleaner and maintenance with ADLER Top-Care.

GUARANTEE CONDITIONS

The conditions for granting the guarantee are the successful registration via our website as well as compliance with the following points:

- Register on the website www.adler-coatings.com/ diamond – You will then receive a confirmation e-mail. Store it as proof.
- Closely follow the instructions of the current technical data sheets.
- Keep the invoice as proof of installation date.
- Supply your end customer with the maintenance manual for all windows and doors so that they can read the relevant information concerning the correct maintenance and repair in the case of damage.
