

In the year 1934, Johann Berghofer opened a paint store in the Austrian town of Schwaz and, over the course of the years, it developed into the paint and varnish manufacturer ADLER. This is a high-quality, resilient and, above all, sustainable furniture varnish with an extremely low VOC content of less than 6 %.
